# Shabbat Guide

"Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy. Six days you shall labor, and do all your work, but the seventh day is a Sabbath to ADONAI your God. On it you shall not do any work, you, or your son, or your daughter, your male servant, or your female servant, or your livestock, or the sojourner who is within your gates. Y'seem-aych Elohim k'Sarah, Rivkah, Ra-chel, v'Leah

May Elohim make you, my daughters, like Sarah, Rebekah, Rachel, and Leah.

#### **Blessings Over the Wife: Proverbs 31**

An excellent wife, who can find? For her worth is far above jewels The heart of her husband trusts in her And he will have no lack of gain She does him good and not evil All the days of her life

She looks for wool and flax And she works with her hands in delight

She is like merchant ships She brings food from afar She rises while it's still night And gives food to her household And portions to her maidservants

#### **Blessing Over the Wine:**

As we drink the wine we remember the blood of Messiah that was poured out for us.

Blessed are You, Adonai, our Elohim, King of the universe Who creates the fruit of the vine. Amen

#### Blessing Over the Bread:

As we remember the provision of God in our lives we also remember that Yeshua said to pray in this manner "...Give us this day our daily bread." We know that Yeshua is our bread, our double portion, whose Body was broken on our behalf.
